Basic Welding Class

Intermediate Welding Class

Using knowledge from the basic course, the intermediate class will help you develop in-depth skills with a focus on techniques and proficiency in the welding field. Practice out of position welding (vertical up and overhead), oxy-fuel cutting, plasma arc cutting, and welding on materials such as stainless steel and aluminum. Enhance your skill level and overall welding abilities.
